SEE REVERSE SIDE

You should begin experiencing multiple loose bowel movements. The goal is for stools to be as clear as

possible. If you do not begin having bowel activity by 9:00 pm, Call the doctor on call (913) 338-8388.

If you become nauseated, stop drinking mixture for 30 minutes, then start again.



The better you prep, the better the exam.

DAY OF YOUR TEST

• If you take a heart, blood pressure, or seizure medication routinely - it is okay to take this medication early in the morning of your procedure.

• HOLD ALL OTHER MEDICATIONS THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE.

- Arrive for your exam at the time listed on the reverse side (no later).
- No smoking the day of your procedure.

PLEASE NOTE

- Do not take prescription blood thinners at least 4 days before your exam.
- Do not take Aspirin, Plavix, or arthritis medications the day of your exam.
- Hold prescription diet pills, i.e.-phentermine, 7 days prior to procedure.
- Drink plenty of clear liquids the day before your test (at least 8 oz. every hour).
- If you are diabetic: NO INSULIN OR ORAL MEDICATIONS THE MORNING OF THE PROCEDURE. TAKE ONLY HALF A DOSE THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE.

You must have with you:

- A responsible adult to drive you home must be present at the time of check-in and stay at the facility or your colonoscopy will be CANCELLED.
- No working, driving, operating machinery, or making legal decisions for 24 hours after procedure.
- A list of all medications you are now taking, including over-the-counter products and herbal supplements.
- · A list of any allergies you have.
- If you have a Pacemaker/AICD please bring in your Pacemaker/AICD card.

During your procedure you will be administered either general anesthesia or heavy sedation. For your safety, it is essential you follow the above instructions.

· No liquids of any kind up to 4 hours prior to your arrival time

Failure to comply with these instructions will result in the cancellation or delay of your procedure. Judgement will be made by your anesthesia provider.
