COLONOSCOPY PREP USING MOVI PREP[®] for procedures scheduled <u>BEFORE 10:00AM</u>

To ensure that your test is accurate and complete, you <u>must</u> follow these directions. If you have questions, please call our office at 816-554-3838. Summit Gastroenterology is dedicated to providing you with quality health care. *You matter to us!*

- ** Purchase MoviPrep[®] from pharmacy (prescription required) DISREGARD DIRECTIONS ON BOX. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS LISTED BELOW ONLY.
- ** Purchase 1 10 oz. bottle of Magnesium Citrate from the laxative section in pharmacy (over the counter). Not red!

A week before your procedure:

- Check with your prescribing doctor to make sure it is safe to hold prescription blood thinners (i.e. Coumadin/ Pradaxa) for 4 days prior. No aspirin or plavix the day of the procedure.
- Hold presciption diet pills, ie-phentermine, 7 days prior to procedure.

Clear Liquids Only the entire day of the day before your procedure.

- Clear liquids permitted are as follows: (water, tea, black coffee, apple juice, white grape and apple juices, lemon or lime Jell-OTM, chicken or beef broth (NO noodles!), popsicles, soda pop, cola's, 7 UPTM and SpriteTM).
- You may have liquid Boost (not powder) or Ensure until 3pm ONLY (no substitutions).
- Do Not drink Alcohol, Do Not drink Milk products, Do Not drink <u>**RED**</u>, <u>**ORANGE**</u> or <u>**PURPLE**</u> clear liquids. Do Not drink Orange Juice.
- ** If you are diabetic, take only half of your normal dose of insulin or oral medications.

At 3:00 PM on the day before your procedure, start drinking MoviPrep[®] solution.

- Empty <u>1 Pouch A & 1 Pouch B</u> into the disposable container. Add water to the top line of the container. Mix to dissolve. The MoviPrep[®] container is divided by 4 marks.
- Every 15 minutes, drink the solution down to the next water mark (approximately 8 ounces), until the full liter is completed.
- After completing the MoviPrep[®] solution, drink 16 ounces of other clear liquids mentioned above.
- If you have not had a bowel movement by 5:00 PM, drink 1 bottle of Magnesium Citrate over 20 minutes.

At 8:00 PM the day before your procedure, drink the 2nd portion of the MoviPrep[®] solution.

- Empty <u>1 Pouch A & 1 Pouch B</u> into the disposable container. Add water to the top line of the container. Mix to dissolve.
- The MoviPrep[®] container is divided by 4 marks.
- Every 15 minutes, drink the solution down to the next water mark (approximately 8 ounces), until the full liter is completed.
- After completing the MoviPrep[®] solution, drink 16 ounces of other clear liquids mentioned above until you go to bed.
- May take water up until **4 hours** prior to procedure time.

The day of your procedure:

- If you take insulin or oral diabetic medication, you are advised to HOLD and DO NOT TAKE on the day of your procedure. Bring it with you.
- Take any heart, blood pressure or seizure medications routinely with a small sip of water.
- No liquids of any kind 4 hours prior to procedure
- No work, no driving, operating machinery or making legal decisions x 24 hours after procedure.
- No smoking the day of the procedure.

You must have with you:

- A responsible adult to drive you home must be present at the check-in and stay at the facility or your colonoscopy will be CANCELLED. They will need to stay with you for 12 hours afterwards.
- A list of all medications you are now taking, including over-the-counter products and herbal supplements.
- A list of any allergies you have.
- If you have a Pacemaker/AICD please bring in you Pacemaker/AICD card.

COLON CLEANSING TIPS:

- Walking will help move the solution through your body.
- Drink the MoviPrep chilled. Make sure to put the MoviPrep jug back into the refrigerator between 8 ounce servings.
- It may be helpful to drink sips of the MoviPrep[®] through a long straw.
- If you feel bloated or your stomach feels "full", slow down drinking the MoviPrep[®]. Drink 8 ounces of MoviPrep[®] every 20 minutes (instead of every 15 minutes).

NPO STATUS: During your procedure you will be administered either general anesthesia or heavy sedation. For your safety, it is essential you follow the above instructions.

• No liquids of any kind up to 4 hours prior to your arrival time

Failure to comply with these instructions will result in the cancellation or delay of your procedure. Judgment will be made by your anesthesia provider.

REMEMBER – the goal is to get cleaned out. If you have any problems with the prep, please contact our office (816) 554-3838 during business hours or (913) 338-8388 after hours to speak with the doctor on call.

* CANCELLATION POLICY *

\$50 fee for cancellation of endoscopy appointments with less than 48 hours notification. If you need to cancel or reschedule, call Summit GI at 816-554-3838, NOT the facility where your procedure is scheduled.
